A Win, Win for Everyone

A Win for Future State Budgets

- HB 35 and SB 49 will make electric school buses available and affordable for every New Mexico School District.
- Aging diesel buses are expensive to operate, fuel, and maintain. Districts are estimated to save between \$8,000 \$15,000 per school bus every year with electric buses.
- Electric buses can serve as batteries on the grid (V2G) and improve access to chargers in rural New Mexico, earning schools up to \$200,000 over the lifespan of each bus.

A Win for Students, Drivers, and Educators

- Electric buses let off fewer emissions, which can reduce asthma and other respiratory problems for students and improve academic achievement.
- Because EVs are nearly silent, drivers can hear what is happening on the bus, so students and drivers have safer, quieter rides.
- School bus **operators and mechanics love them** because there are no gears to worry about, and power delivery is smooth with an instant response.

Retiring diesel buses in favor of electric buses has **big benefits for New Mexico** students, teachers, school and state budgets, bus drivers, and communities.
